

Tabir 2012-13 Hiking Gear

Yunatsvo will be split into two groups based on age/experience and will go on two separate overnight hikes. You will require the following items:

	Item	Notes
	Hiking Tent	If you have one. Plast will be providing tents
	Small, Light Weight Sleeping Bag	Ensure it is a small sleeping bag, not one that takes up your entire hiking pack.
	Sleeping Mat	Foam mat or thermorest. Do not bring a heavy blow up air bed for hiking purposes
	Water Bottle/s	You MUST be able to carry at least 3L of water. It's likely to be a hot summer and there isn't regular access to water on the hikes
	Raincoat	
	Cooking Gear	Stove, pot, gas/fuel. Cooking will be done in groups of 3. Bring your own gear. Do not assume some else will bring gear for you
	Eating Utensils	Light weight plate, cutlery, cup/bowl.
	Toiletries	Toothbrush, deodorant, other personal items
	Toothpaste	1 tube between 3 people. There is no point 3 people carrying 100g of toothpaste each
	Torch	Ensure your batteries are fully charged so that you don't have to carry a spare battery
	Pack liner/heavy duty garbage bags	This is to protect your gear from rain, creek crossing and any spillages that may occur in your bags.
	2 Pairs underwear	
	2 Pairs Hiking Socks	
	2 Light Weight T-shirts	
	1 Pair of Shorts or Long Pants to Hike in	
	1 Spare Pair of Shorts or Long pants	For the campsite or in case your hiking pair gets wet
	1 Fleece Jumper	
	Boots

Additional Gear for Yunaku aged +15

	Item	Notes
	Swimmers & Boardies	
	Hand/Microfibre Towel	To dry yourself after swimming/wading
	Shoes You Can Get Wet	Crocs, volleys or some other type of enclose shoe. Thongs as a last resort.
	Packliner/Heavy Duty Garbage Bags	You must be able to fit you whole backpack into a garbage bag and seal it up completely from water. You may be required to use your backpack as a floatation device for river crossings.
