Introduction

'No Jab, No Play' is the name of legislation that requires all children to be fully vaccinated unless they have a medical exemption to be enrolled in childcare or kindergarten.

Policy

Plast Australia supports the Australian Government "No Jab No Play" policy and encourages up to date vaccinations for all children.

Plast Australia will not exclude any participant from organised activities if un-immunised, however in the event of a participant presenting with a contagious illness, or in the opinion of organisers posing an unacceptable risk to others, the un-immunised participant may be placed in isolation from the rest of the group for specific activities or periods or, if considered necessary and practical, sent home.
